I found it very relevant to me both personally and professionally. The content of the theory, the examples given and the practical application of the theory were all beneficial in helping me become clearer and more comfortable with the ideas of 1st, 2nd and 3rd position coaching. I feel I am now in a better position to begin to practice using these techniques in preparation for using them professionally as a coach, as well as in my personal life and interactions with others.

I just liked the way that Noel facilitated the teleclass. He is a good listener, seems very conscious of the group, he stayed on track whilst allowing us to explore topics of interest or tangents as they arose, bringing us back on track when appropriate. He encouraged all participants to contribute without forcing anyone. He created a safe environment in which to share. He presented the topics clearly and by using great examples to help us understand, including diagrams for the visual learners. He shared his own experiences of using the techniques which made the teleclass more interesting and inspiring, without causing us to feel he was at all focused on himself.

Personally I will be more mindful of my position when I am in conversation or interacting with others. I have a very strong tendency toward first position but will now be trying to more appropriately use all three positions.

Professionally I really feel like I have added to my toolkit. It will enable me to have avenues of investigation that I might not have realised I had before. Especially making effective use of third position.

It is really great to know that you have someone knowledgeable leading you in the discussion so that all the salient points can be identified, discussed and reviewed. Their competence rubs off on everyone else and we are all better for the experience.

The class provided me with a totally new way of looking at the coaching experience. This perceptual field model is something I have never really considered using, although I have used certain aspects under a different name. I now have a format with which to begin experimenting with this model on its own and in conjunction with the Grow Model.

Course will be helpful to coaching as it provides a model to move into other thinking/emotional positions when working with clients.

I found it very relevant to coaching in all areas of my business. I feel it also is a great tool to provide perspective in most situations, both personally and professionally.

Certainly relevant, had never thought of having a conversation that way, and can see how effective it could be. Actually realised that have used it in a way without being really aware of what I was doing, ie when using the 'grow model' usually in 2nd position and as in 3rd position when working in the early days with my team in the office, and using the 'what would work for us' viewpoint.

I found the course appropriate to me personally as it has given me a different perspective on my coaching style, and abilities.

Professionally it has cemented my previous knowledge of NLP in a practical and useful way. In fact it has simplified it with out missing out on anything.
